

JARDS: Usage of the new home-organization login (SSO)

To keep your existing JARDS account when switching to the new home-organization login (SSO), the email address used in JARDS must be **identical** to the email address used by your home organization's Identity Provider (IdP).

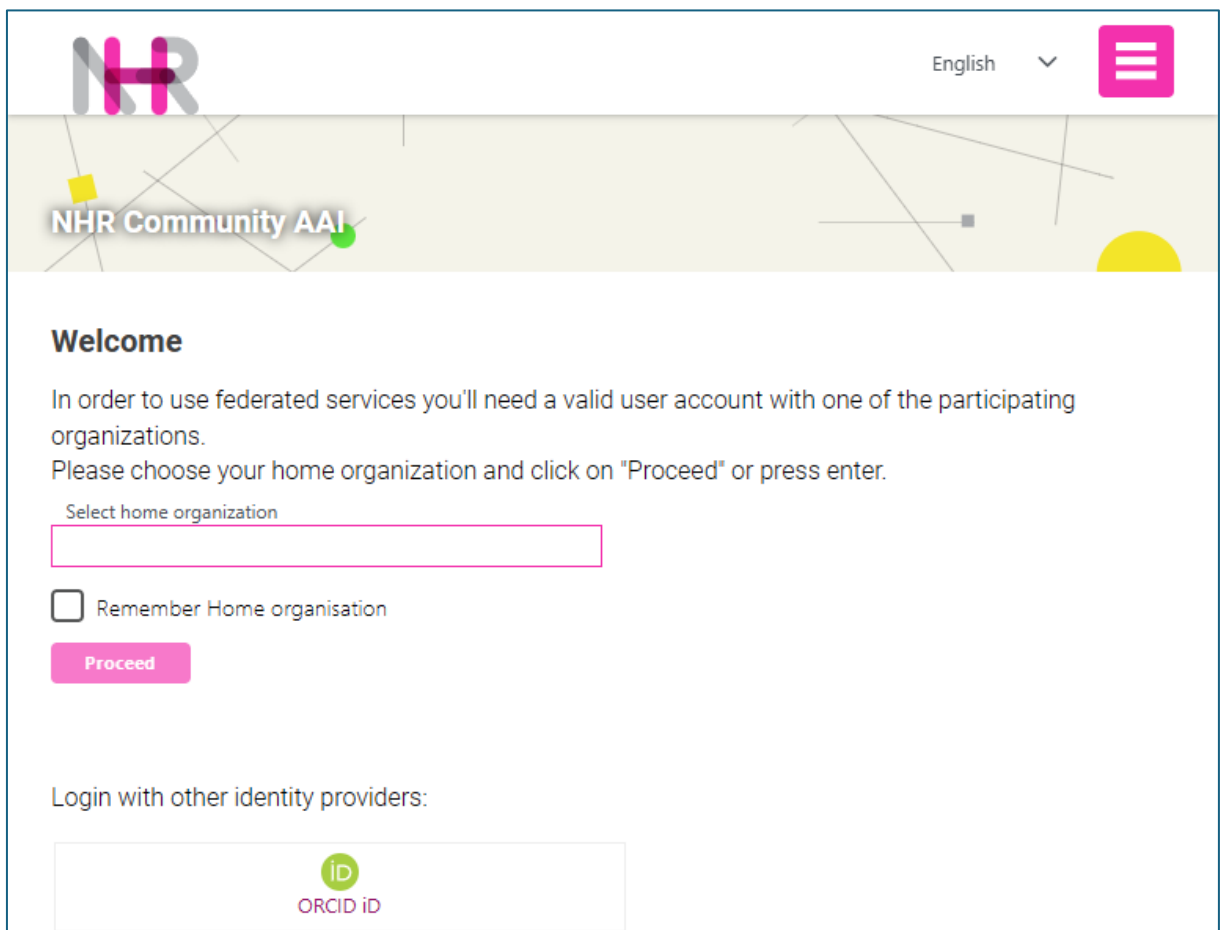
- In **Step 1**, you check which email address your IdP uses.
- If the email address is different, you must **change it in JARDS** in **Step 2** (or alternatively at your home organization).
- Once both email addresses match, proceed to **Step 3** and log in via SSO.

1. Check which email address your Identity Provider uses

- Log in to the NHR Community AAI (CAAI):

<https://login.nhr-verein.de>

You can authenticate using your home organization or your ORCID iD.

- Navigate to

`Index -> Personal Data`



- c. Check the value in the field “**E-Mail address**”.
- If this email address is the same as the one you currently use in JARDS via email callback, you can proceed directly to **Step 3**
 - If it differs, continue with **Step 2**.

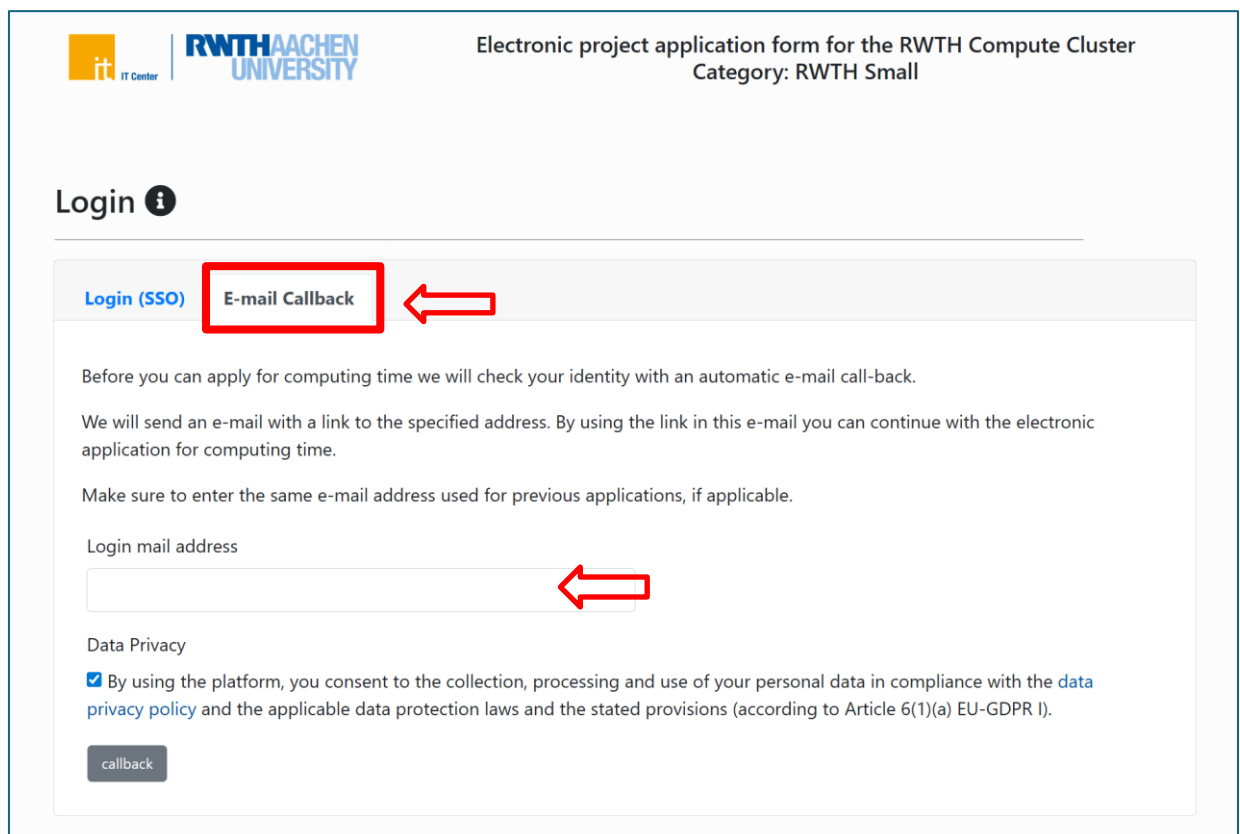
2. If the email address is different, change your JARDS email

Note: As an alternative, you can also change the primary email address at your home organization (Identity Provider) so that it matches the one in JARDS.

- a. First, log in to JARDS **via email callback** (not via SSO!), for example:

Please use your “**old**” email address (i.e., the one you always used to log into JARDS).

Make sure to enter the same e-mail address used for previous applications, if applicable.

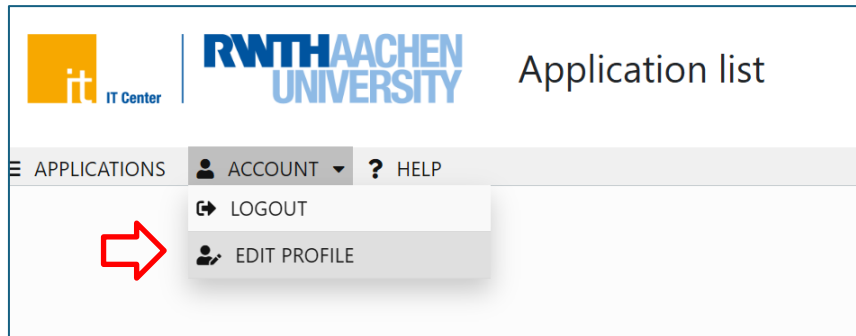

- b. Navigate to

`ACCOUNT -> EDIT PROFILE`



- c. Scroll down to **“Change E-mail”**, update the email address so that it matches the email from your Identity Provider, and click **submit**.

Please note that once the change is confirmed, you will no longer be able to log in using your current e-mail address.

Important:

This only works if you have **never used this new email address in JARDS before** (i.e. you do *not* already have a second JARDS account with that email).

- If a second account already exists, you must either change the email address at your home organization instead or continue using the email callback for now.
- A merge of JARDS accounts will be possible in a future release.

- d. Confirm the change by following the instructions in the confirmation email you receive.

3. Log in to JARDS via SSO

- a. Log in to JARDS using your home organization (SSO, ORCID, etc.):

E-mail Callback

We recommend to use the single sign-on (SSO) method for authorization. You can still use the previous email callback method by selecting the corresponding tab above. However, this option will be disabled after October 2, 2026.

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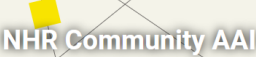

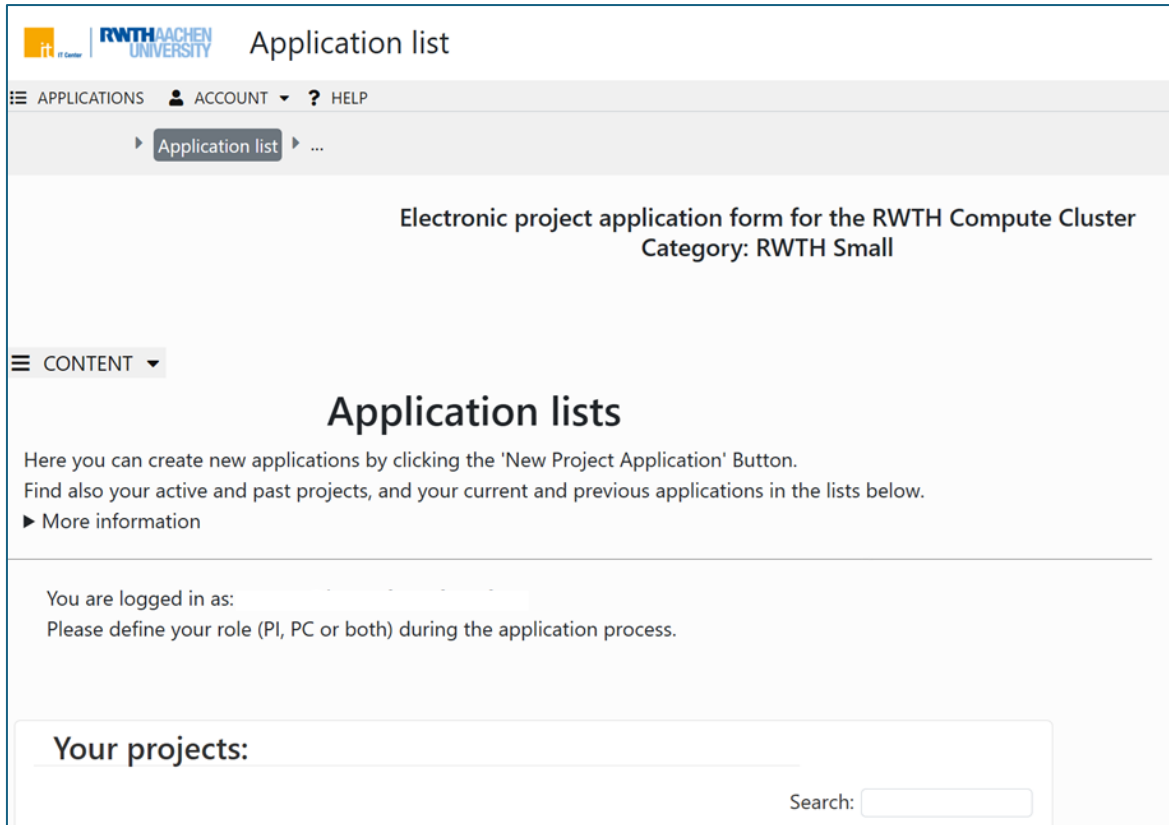
